

## What food can I put in my kerbside food caddy?

Remember, all food can go into your food caddy. This includes foods that you can't compost at home such as raw and cooked meat and fish.



- ✓ Raw vegetables
- ✓ Cooked vegetables
- ✓ Whole fruit
- ✓ Peelings



- ✓ Tea bags
- ✓ Coffee grounds



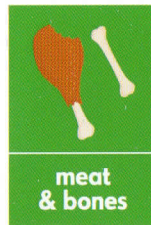
- ✓ Bread
- ✓ Cakes
- ✓ Pastries



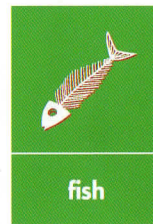
- ✓ Rice
- ✓ Pasta
- ✓ Beans



- ✓ Dairy products
- ✓ Cheese
- ✓ Eggs



- ✓ Raw meat
- ✓ Cooked meat
- ✓ Bones



- ✓ Raw and cooked fish

Remember to recycle your mouldy and out of date food, including ready meals removed from their packaging



- ✓ All uneaten food and plate scrapings

## Please do not put any of the following into your kerbside food caddy

- ✗ Packaging of any kind
- ✗ Liquids, such as milk
- ✗ Oil or liquid fat
- ✗ Any material that is not food waste
- ✗ Plastic bags or non Derbyshire Dales District Council liners

## Using your food recycling collection

1. Line your kitchen caddy with one of the liners supplied by Derbyshire Dales District Council and put your food waste in it. Or simply put food waste directly into your kitchen caddy.



**Top Tip**  
If you would rather use your own indoor container that's fine - do whatever works for you

2. Whenever you need to empty your caddy, tie the top of the liner and put it in your kerbside food caddy.



**Top Tip**  
Remember to not let your kitchen caddy get too full before emptying it

3. Remember your kerbside caddy comes with a lockable handle. **Please put your food recycling out for collection by 7.00am every week on your collection day.**
